PACKING & SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS

DNA Ear Tag or DNA Ear Tissue Sample Collectors- Shipping Instructions:

- DNA ear tags or ear tissue sample only collectors do not require refrigeration. After collection store at room temperature for up to 3 years.
- Package ear tissue sample collector, submission form, and payment in a small box or sturdy envelope (bubble or tear resistant).
- Mail using your preferred method (expedited shipping is not necessary) to the above address.

Blood Tube- Shipping Instructions:

- After drawing blood into purple top tubes, **rock** the tubes gently back and forth to mix the preservative (EDTA) with the blood.
- **Chill** blood as soon after collection as possible, keeping it chilled until mailing. Chilled blood can be stored for 7-10 days.
- Package **blood, submission form, and payment** into a well-padded box with an **ice/gel pack in warmer months**.
- Ship to above address using one of the following: **Priority (2-5 days)** or **express or overnight (1-2 days)** shipping service.
- We accept **checks, money order, or credit cards** (VISA or Mastercard only) for payment. **Please include payment with samples.**

Notes:

- *Codon 171 is the most commonly tested codon. It is used to test for susceptibility to strain C scrapie (the most common form of scrapie in the U.S.) Result possibilities are QQ, QR or RR
- *QR and RR sheep are resistant to strain C scrapie.
- *Codon 136 is used to test for susceptibility to Strain A scrapie (recently discovered in the U.S.) Result possibilities are VV, AV, AA.
- *Codon 136 is necessary only on QR and QQ animals. It is not necessary to test RR animals as they are automatically AA at codon 136.
- *Only AA sheep are resistant to strain A scrapie.
- *Testing at codon 154 is generally used only for research purposes.
